You know in your heart what’s right; so let’s do what’s right.

Shouldn't you share these insights with fellow believers? In the past, far too many of them have been misled into either voting for their pocketbooks (instead of principles), or supporting a party that *seems* "sort of Christian" — even though it consistently refused to take a stand on moral issues that matter deeply to believers of all faiths... Or they were duped into voting for Christian candidates in parties that wouldn't support their moral convictions — and would even punish them for stating their convictions.

Let's get something straight: the goal in the next election isn't merely to 'get rid of the Liberals' —

We can and must restore morality in Ottawa!

ONLY the CHP stands for these important principles:

- **Protecting innocent human life**

Killing 110,000 babies a year for being inconvenient is barbaric! In 60% of abortions, the mother is coerced into the decision. The CHP believes women facing unanticipated pregnancies should be offered comfort, counsel and non-lethal alternatives. Abortion doesn't belong in any 'health-care' plan, for it cures no known disease, kills half the patients — the babies — and increases the mother's risk of breast cancer by 30% or more. The CHP is Canada's only pro-Life federal political party.

- **Preserving traditional marriage**

Only the CHP has the courage to oppose the homosexual agenda to re-define marriage. Recognition of same-sex 'marriage' would send a dangerous message to our children: such an action by Parliament would imply that "it's OK to be 'gay'." But homosexuality is not an innate condition. Studies that purport to prove that homosexuality is genetic have been proven false when subjected to scientific peer review.

Homosexuality is a behavioural addiction that spreads many diseases. We spend millions of dollars to persuade children not to take up smoking, because if they become addicted, that habit will cut an average of seven years off their lives; then we allow homosexual activists in the schools and the media to tell them it's acceptable to play around with a habit which, if they become addicted, can cut three times as much from their life expectancy. That makes no sense at all!

CHP Members of Parliament will work in the House of Commons for the repeal of Bill C-250!

- **Saving the Constitution; ending judge-made law**

The Supreme Court is destroying democracy by usurping Parliament's exclusive role as lawmaker. But only the CHP has proposed a plan to restrain judicial activism.

Senator Ann Cools once said, “The problem is not just judicial activism; it’s also cowardice in the House of Commons.” None of the parties we’ve elected in the past has been willing to protect democracy and the Canadian Constitution by standing up to unelected, unaccountable judges who are systematically destroying our children’s future and Canada’s democracy. The CHP will.

• **Strengthening families**

Surveys show that 77% of mothers who work outside the home would rather be with their children, if they could afford it. *Let’s make that possible!*

The CHP’s ‘Family-Friendly Tax Credit’ is a plan to allow more parents to raise their own children. It would provide a \$1,000/month tax credit to families with children of school-age or younger, if either parent stays home. This would mean

- better care for the children
- stronger families
- 1.5 to 2 million existing jobs would open up, helping to reduce unemployment
- taxpayers would escape billions of dollars in extra taxes that would result from the Liberals’ national daycare scheme
- the revenues lost by the tax credit would be more than offset by savings in Employment Insurance and social assistance payouts

• **Supporting preventive health care**

Lifestyle education can reduce health care costs. The Romanow Report recommended campaigns to combat smoking and obesity; that would be a start. But there are other behaviours that the Romanow Report didn’t touch, like abortion, sexual promiscuity and the two most common — and preventable — birth defects: FAS (fetal alcohol syndrome) and FAE (fetal alcohol effect).

We can save billions, and rescue millions of destroyed lives, by promoting preventive health measures.

• **Restoring labour peace**

Too often, the public and innocent third parties are held to ransom in labour disputes. The CHP proposes free collective bargaining, mediation and binding arbitration to end costly strikes.

• **Ending imports that use slave and child labour**

Imports from nations that use or allow slave and exploitive child labour must be restricted.

• *and much, much more...*

Let’s put an end now to the silly ‘strategic voting’ habit that is destroying democracy in Canada!

Remember: the only ‘wasted vote’ is one cast for a party that doesn’t truly represent what *you* believe in.
