

Canada's Commitment to Earth Worship at the Root of Rapid Change to Canadian Law

Canada is going through gut wrenching legal changes to foundational laws of the land. These changes are being made without citizen approval or consultation. Why is Canada's

government 1) redefining marriage, 2) criminalizing free speech against immoral sexual behaviour, 3) criminalizing spanking, 4) legalizing stem cell research and 5) decriminalizing marijuana?

Canadian "Elites" have committed this nation to the new spiritual vision of the "Earth Charter", a new "Global Ethic", and the new "Ten Commandments" that expects to transcend all religions and countries.

Interview: Maurice Strong on a "People's Earth Charter"

(transcript of interview conducted March 5, 1998)
Mr. Strong is Chairman of the Earth Council and Co-Chair of the Earth Charter Commission.



Our new Prime Minister is fully committed to the implementation of the precepts of the Earth Charter. This spiritual vision was drafted by Mr. Martin's now Senior Advisor and long term mentor, Maurice Strong. Mr. Strong hired Paul in 1967 as his executive assistant while he was the president of Power Corporation. Later Mr. Martin was promoted to President of the Canadian Steamship Lines and then purchased the firm in a sweet deal offered by the Power Corp.

The Steamship Line is now one of the largest in the world thanks to \$161 million dollars in contracts from the Canadian Government. CSL also saved \$100 million dollars of tax savings due to the transfer of the registration to Barbados, a country Mr. Martin allowed to remain a tax shelter. Mr. Strong was mentored Paul and was instrumental in making him very wealthy.



Martin asks auditor to investigate \$161M mistake

OTTAWA - Prime Minister Paul Martin has formally asked the auditor general to investigate a glaring government error in reporting how much business his former shipping company received from Ottawa. Last year, the government told Parliament that Canada Steamship Lines Ltd. received just \$137,000 in government contracts from 1993 to 2002. But last week, it said the figure was actually \$161 million.



In his opening address to the Rio summit, Strong directed the world's attention to the "Declaration of the Sacred Earth" "We must therefore transform our attitudes and values, and adopt a renewed respect for **the superior laws of Divine Nature** "

In the year 2000 he released the Charter by placing it in a replica of the Ark of the Covenant, his "Ark of Hope" He then pronounced "The real goal of the Earth Charter, is that it will in fact become like the Ten Commandments."

Mr. Strong uses the Earth Council, Toronto and University of Peace, Costa Rica, to propagate this new spiritual vision. Strong is the President and UN Secretary General, Kofi Annan is the Honourary President. Former CRTC head, Keith Spicer directs their Institute of Media. The University is funded by the Canadian Government, who provided \$4.8 million dollars in 2001 for its handful of students.

Canada to Contribute \$4.8 Million for Human Rights and Democracy in Latin America

(2001-02) News Release

San José, Costa Rica – Maria Minna, Canada's Minister for International Cooperation, today announced two important initiatives to support democratic development and human rights in Latin America. The Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) will contribute up to **\$4.8 million** to the United Nations **University for Peace** and the Inter-American Institute for Human Rights.

Canada gives \$190,000 for institute programs

Canada's Minister for International Cooperation, the Honorable Susan Whelan, has approved a grant of up to Can. \$300,000 (US \$190,000) "in support of program development of the Institute for Media, Peace and Security." This will enable IMPS, on behalf of the University for Peace, to accelerate considerably the start of its regular academic and training programs

Keith Spicer is former chairman (1989-96) of Canada's broadcasting and telecommunications regulatory body (the CRTC, informally known as the "Canadian FCC").

Strong's Earth Council is also funded by the Canadian Government. In 2002 the Council received \$140,000 from CIDA.

In addition Mr. Strong developed Baca Grande, a 100,000 acre "Spiritual Center" in Colorado. As a result of an Earth Worship prophet visiting the commune, Strong invited to Baca the Lindisfarne Association, the Aspen Institute of Humanistic Studies, the Charmelite Order (Spiritual Life Institute), a Tibetan Order of Buddhists, (who were given 200 acres for the Tibetan Monastery), the Village Group (an alternative community), and Rediscovery-Four Corners (a camp for American Indians). More religious centers have been added.

The Baca Grande

The Baca Grande Estate was acquired in 1978 by Maurice and Hanna Strong. Mr. Strong is the former U.N. Under-Secretary General for the Environment, who organized the 1992 Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro. In keeping with this tradition, the Strongs have given land grants in the Baca Grande to religious lineages and spiritual groups representing many of the world's wisdom traditions. Apart from the land given to H.H.the Karmapa during his visit to the Baca in 1980, these grants have led to the creation of a Carmelite Monastery, the Haidakandi Universal Ashram, the Sri Aurobindo Learning Center and the Crestone Mountain Zen Center, as well as a number of environmental and educational centers. More recently land was granted to the Naropa Institute and to Dzigar Kongtrul Rinpoche and to Chagdud Tulku Rinpoche to establish Tibetan Buddhist retreat facilities. The Baca Grande continues to be blessed by frequent visits from major Buddhist teachers, as well as other spiritual and environmental leaders from throughout the world."


Earth Covenant/Earth Charter partnership
The Earth Covenant process has entered into partnership with the Earth Charter Initiative that was launched in April 1994 by the Green Cross (headed by Mikhail Gorbachev) and the Earth Council (headed by Maurice Strong). The Covenant's multi-sectoral movement - with its fourth principle's focus on global governance and strengthened United Nations structures - enhances the possibility that the Charter will have the broad political support and the public will **move legislatures and heads of State to sign a binding Charter by 2000.**

Mr. Strong is Kofi Anan's Special Advisor and a United Nations diplomat. Through the U.N. they are influencing the laws of the world. The Charter website states "any

declaration of fundamental ethical principles that gains wide acceptance can function as a soft law document that influences the development of international law even if it has not been formally endorsed by the United Nations.” For years they have been presenting this “global ethic” and now it is influencing Canadian law.

The recent radical changes in Canadian law stem directly from the Earth Charter. 1. Redefining marriage and criminalizing free speech against immoral sexual behaviour, is one of the Charter’s fundamental tenets found in section 3.12.a.. Legalizing stem cell research, the growing of babies and harvesting their tissues is in section 2.7.e. Criminalizing spanking and decriminalizing marijuana also are derived from this “new global ethic”. Now the “Elites” of Canada are enshrining these statutes against the will of the people.





Section 3. 12. Uphold the right of all, ...
a. Eliminate discrimination in all its forms, such as that based on race, color, sex, sexual orientation, religion, language, and national, ethnic or social origin.

Section 2.7.
 e. Ensure universal access to health care that fosters reproductive health (*technology*) and responsible reproduction (*abortion*).

Mr. Martin is fully committed to Mr. Strong and his radical agenda to implement this new spiritual vision. Paul Martin recently said “he's obviously somebody that a number of people, including the Secretary-General of the United Nations listens to, and I do too.” Now as Senior Advisor Maurice Strong can follow-up on his belief as stated in his autobiography, "We are all gods now, gods in charge of our own destiny,"




